



Expression



This is a way to ask if a doctor is available or nearby.

"Excuse me, is there a doctor around? My friend needs help."

To know first aid

Verb




To know the procedure for initial, immediate care of an injury. It is usually performed by non-experts.

I learned first aid while I was camping in Alaska.

To choke

Verb



To stop breathing by obstructing the wind pipe in the throat. This is often caused by a piece of food.

Once I choked on a chicken bone. It was scary.

To know the Heimlich

Phrasal verb



To know a special procedure that is done to dislodge a piece of food that is obstructing the wind pipe.

I was choking but the restaurant manager knew the Heimlich.

To pass out

Phrasal verb



To lose consciousness

The boy passed out on the floor after eating the strange substance.

To have a break- in

Expression



To have an intruder enter your home illegally

We had a break-in at our place when we were on vacation last winter.
